Come, Holy Spirit

In the Christian liturgical tradition Veni Sancte Spiritus (Come, Holy Spirit) is a sequence that is sung during the celebration of Pentecost. This was the day on which the Holy Spirit descended upon the followers of Jesus, fifty days after the Resurrection. (A sequence is a chant or hymn sung during the Mass before the reading of the Gospel.)

It is uncertain who wrote the words but they are usually attributed to Cardinal Stephen Langton, the Archbishop of Canterbury from 1207 to 1228. He perhaps wrote it while in exile in France, due to the turbulent political strife between King John of England and Pope Innocent III.

The melody originally associated with the text is a chant in the Gregorian tradition. Through the centuries numerous composers have created their own musical settings. For this work I have chosen to use an English translation of the original Latin text, in order to more immediately communicate the power and very personal quality of the message.

The next-to-last verse of the hymn reads: "Give to your faithful, who trust in you, the sevenfold gifts." This line refers to the seven gifts of the Holy Spirit, derived from a passage in the book of Isaiah, which guide and strengthen followers through their lives: wisdom, understanding, counsel, fortitude, knowledge, piety and fear of the Lord.
